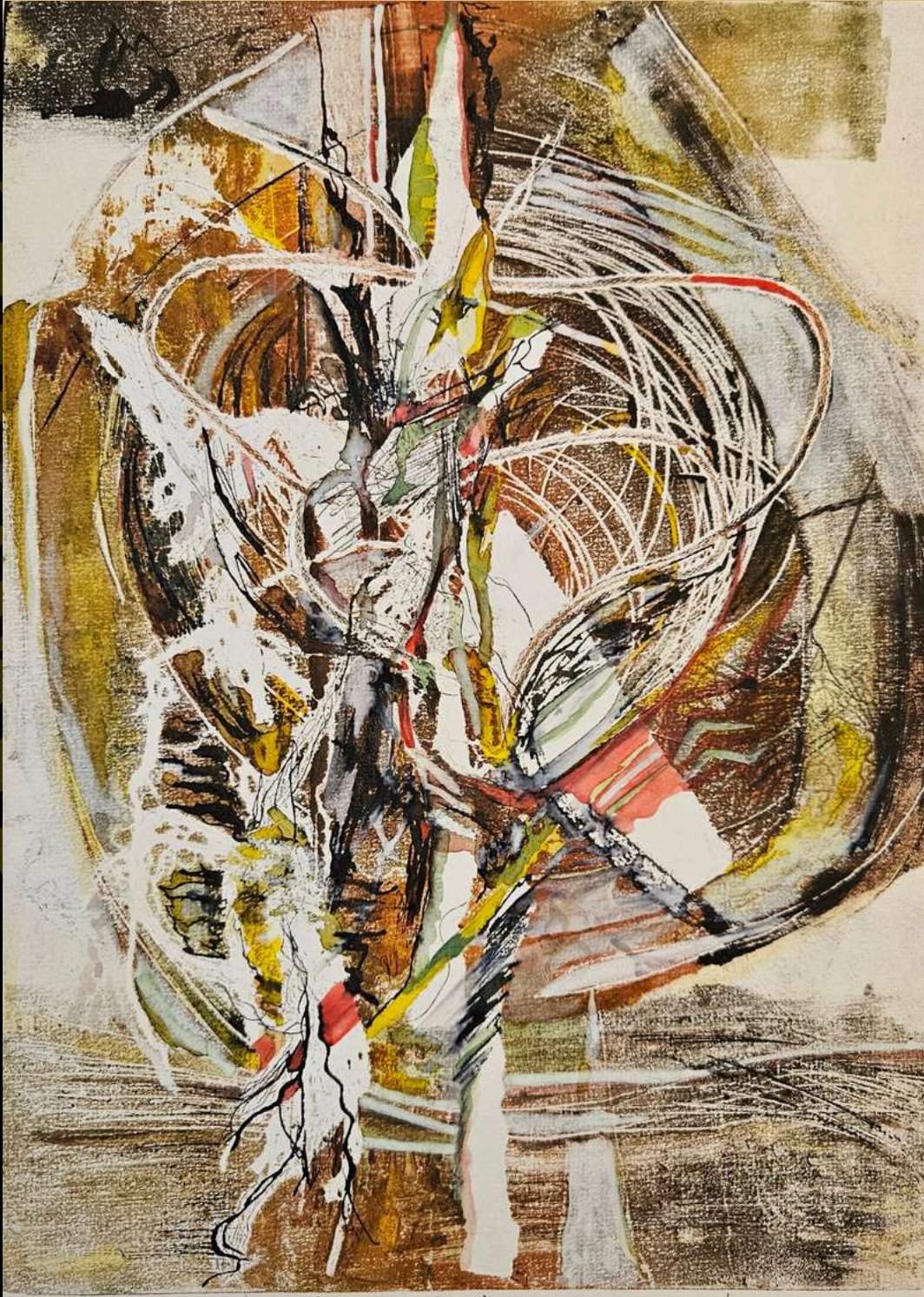
"Urban Dream" - Byron

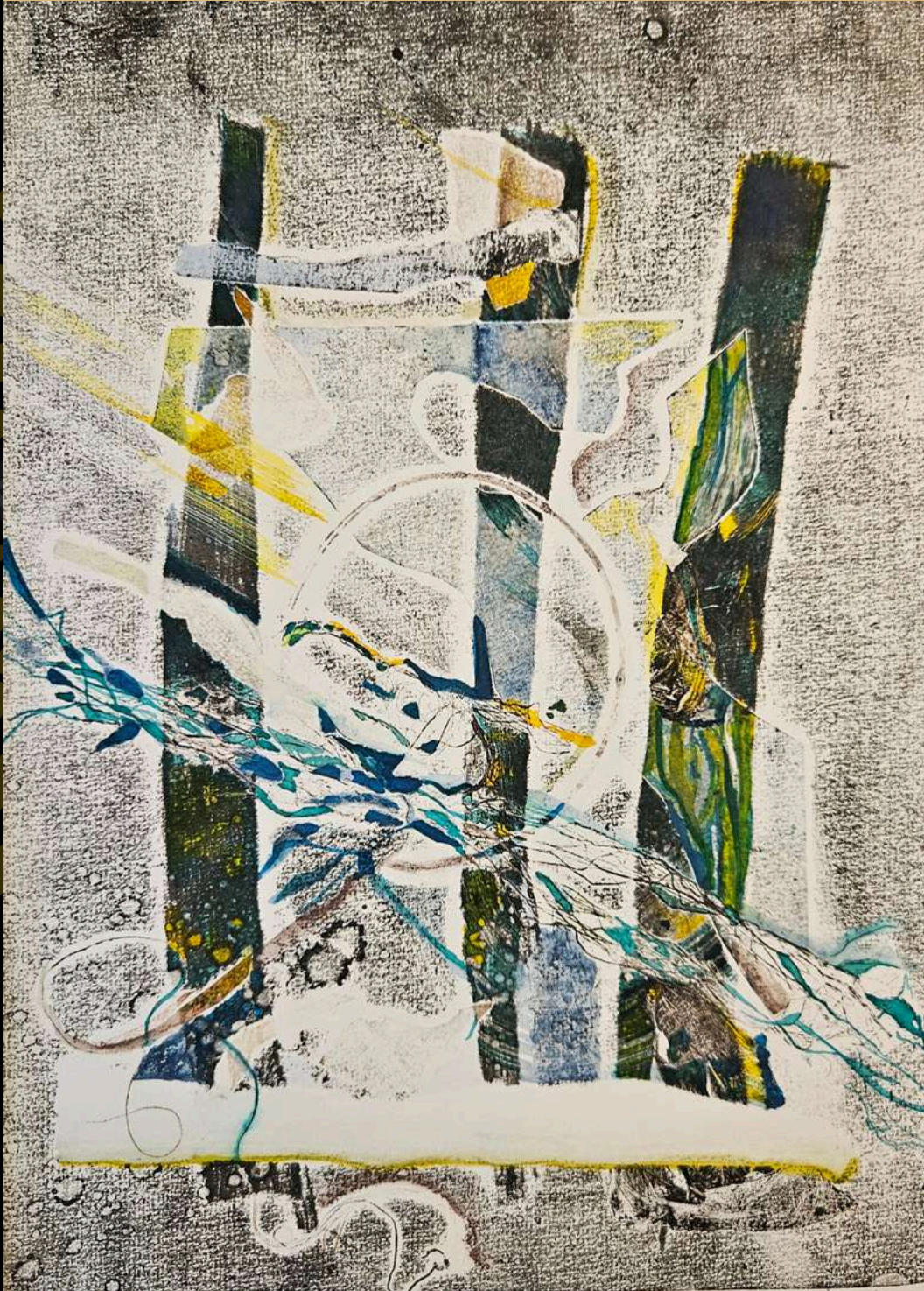

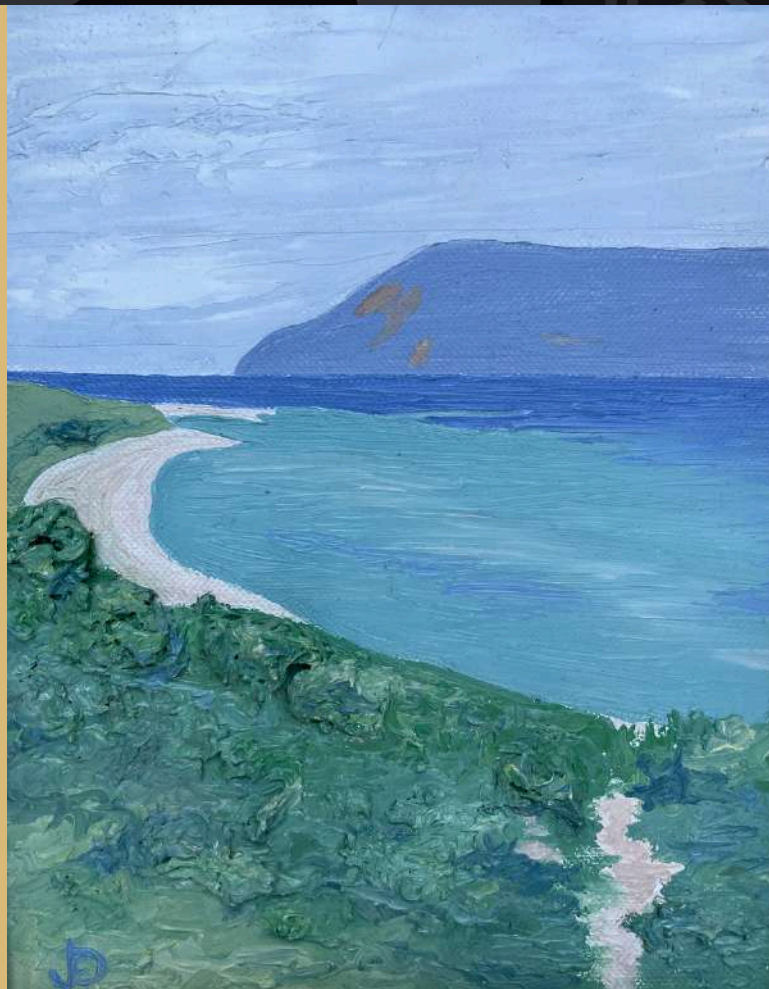

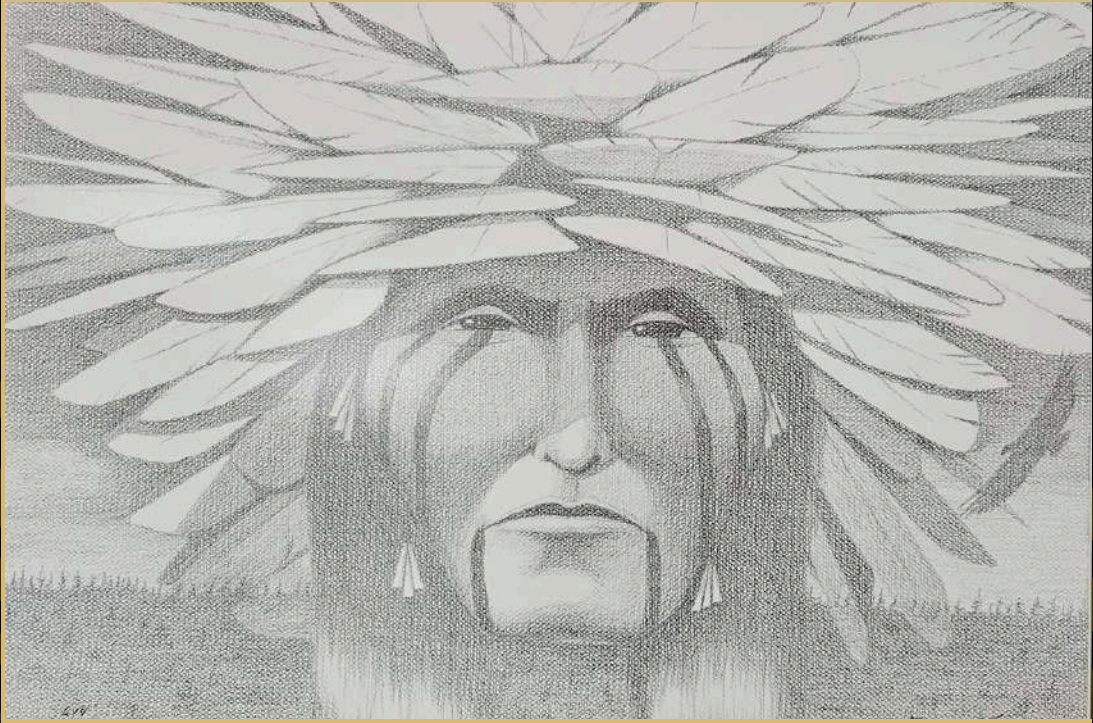
"Dreaming Wolf" - Scott Hill.. USA.

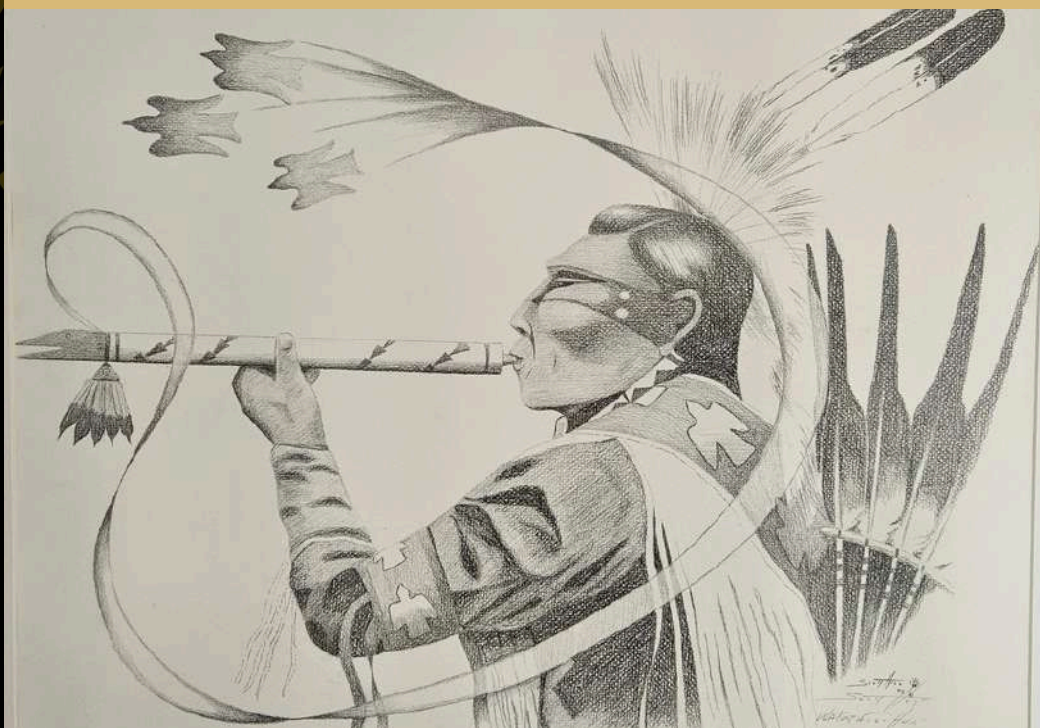
"Warrior" - Scott Hill.. USA.

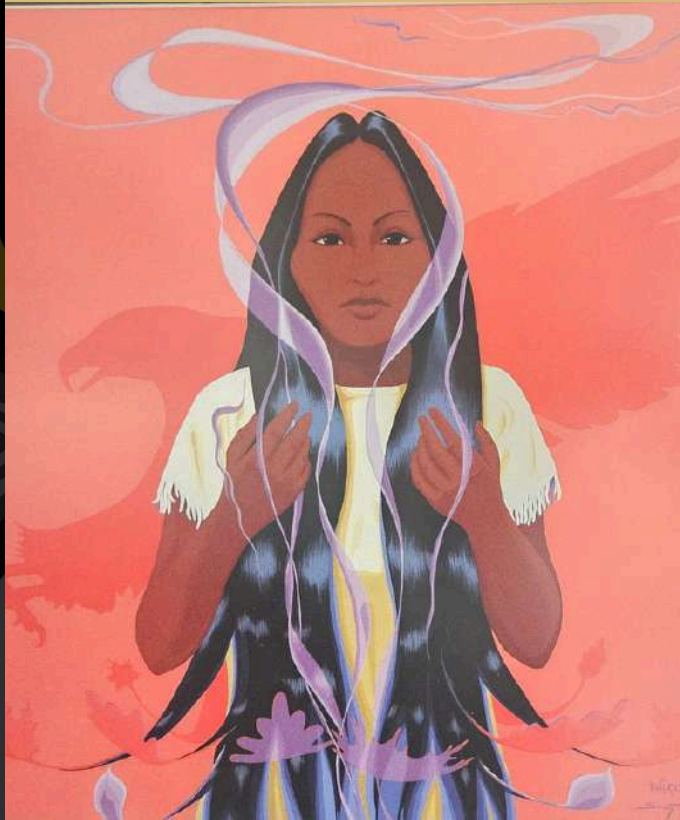

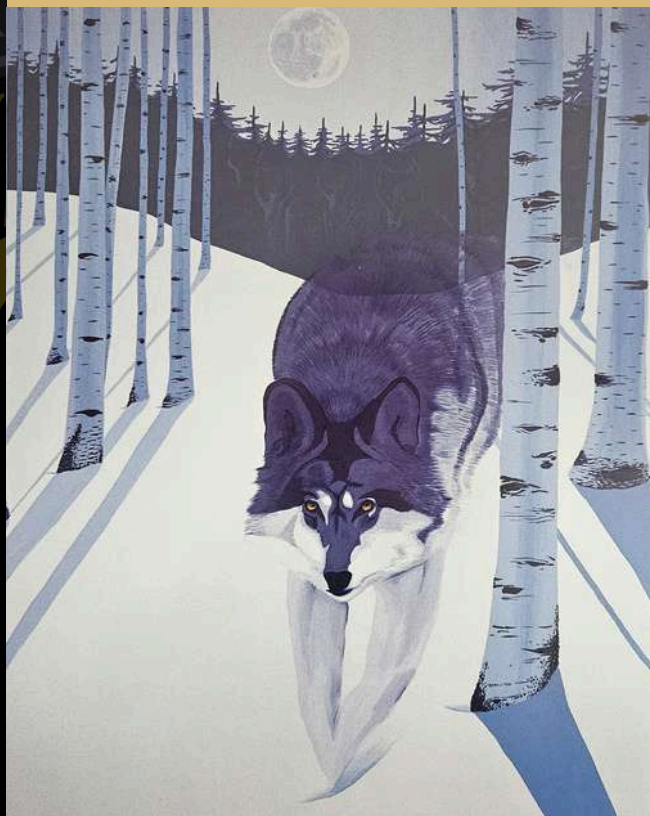
“Pipe Carrier”. Scott Hill.. USA. Drawing on cardboard

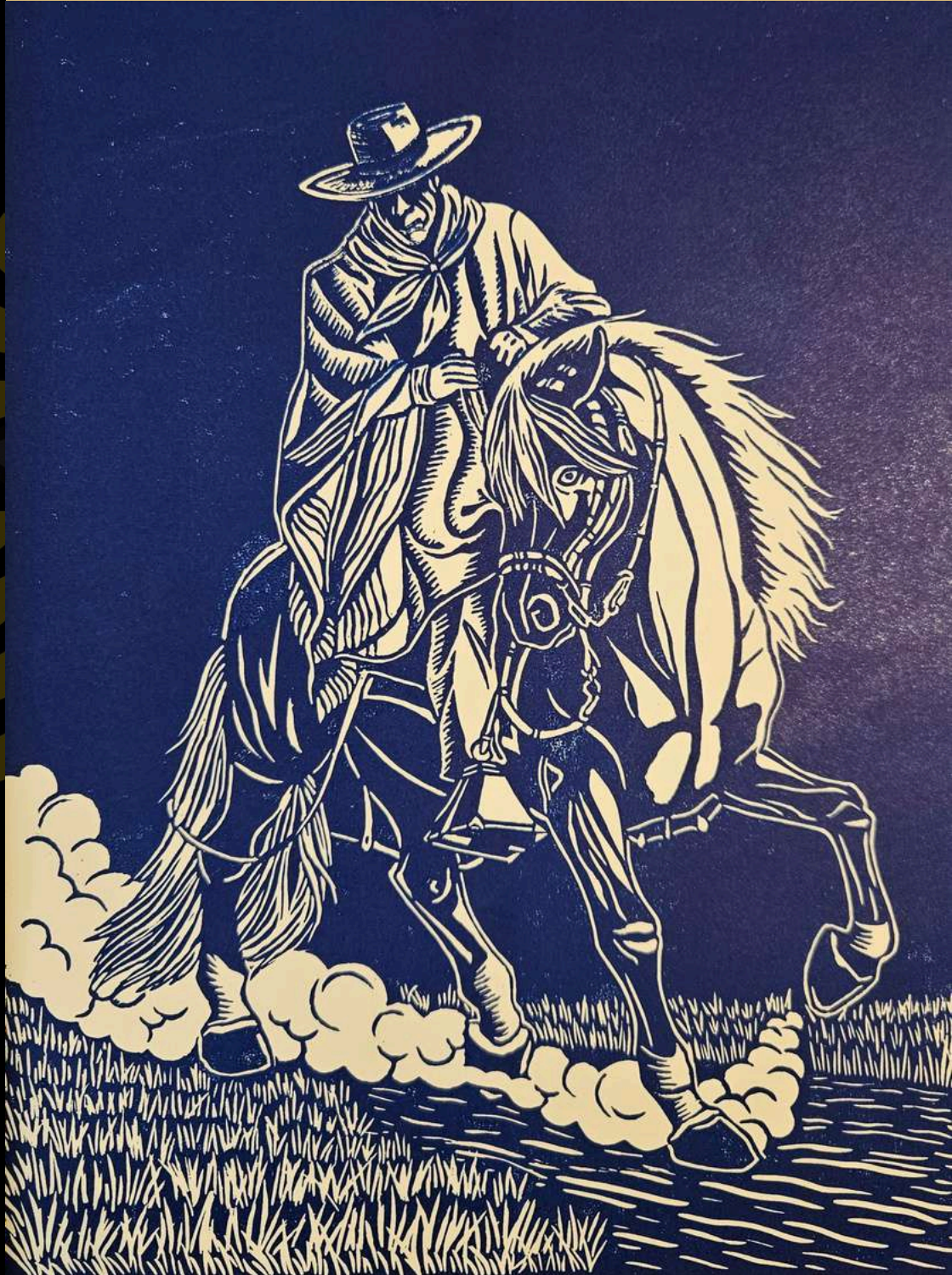
"Winter Spirit". Scott Hill. USA

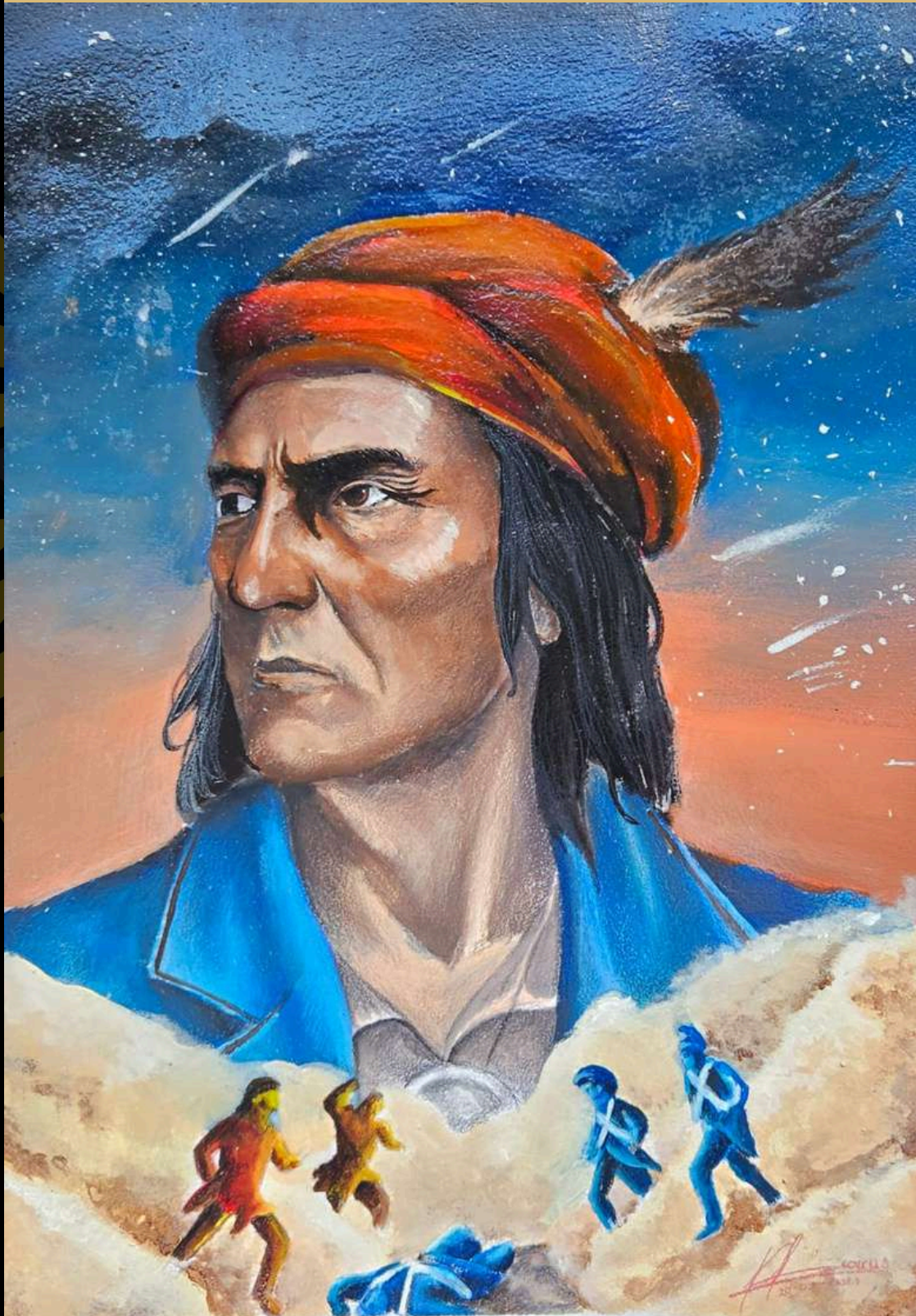

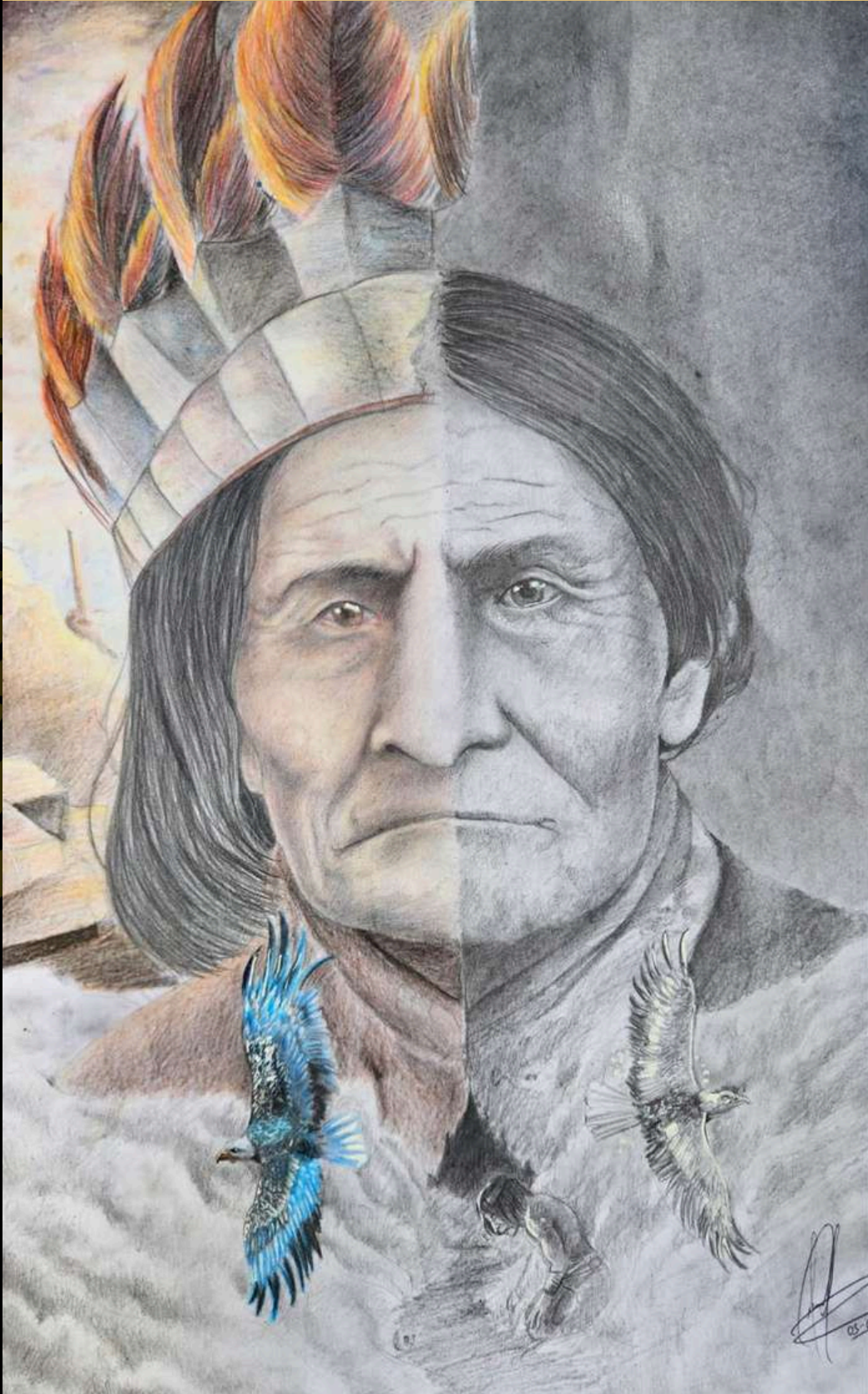

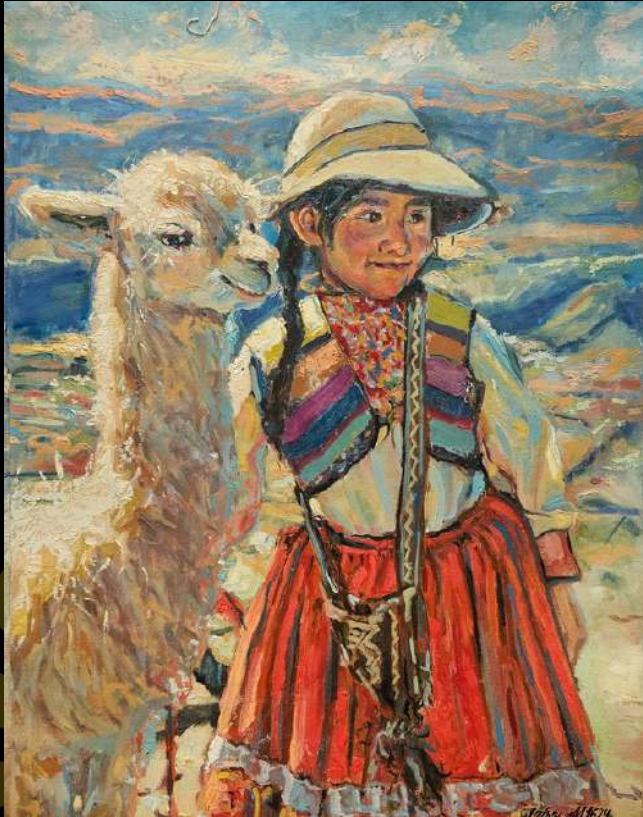




"Amazonía 1" Ana Piaguaje. Ecuador.

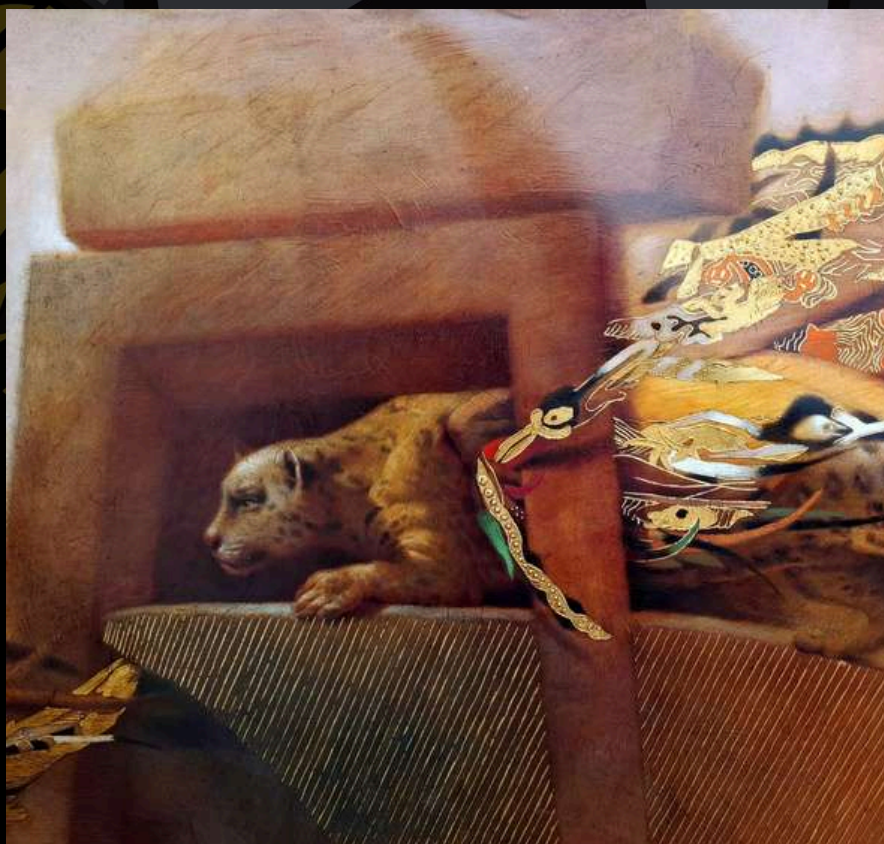

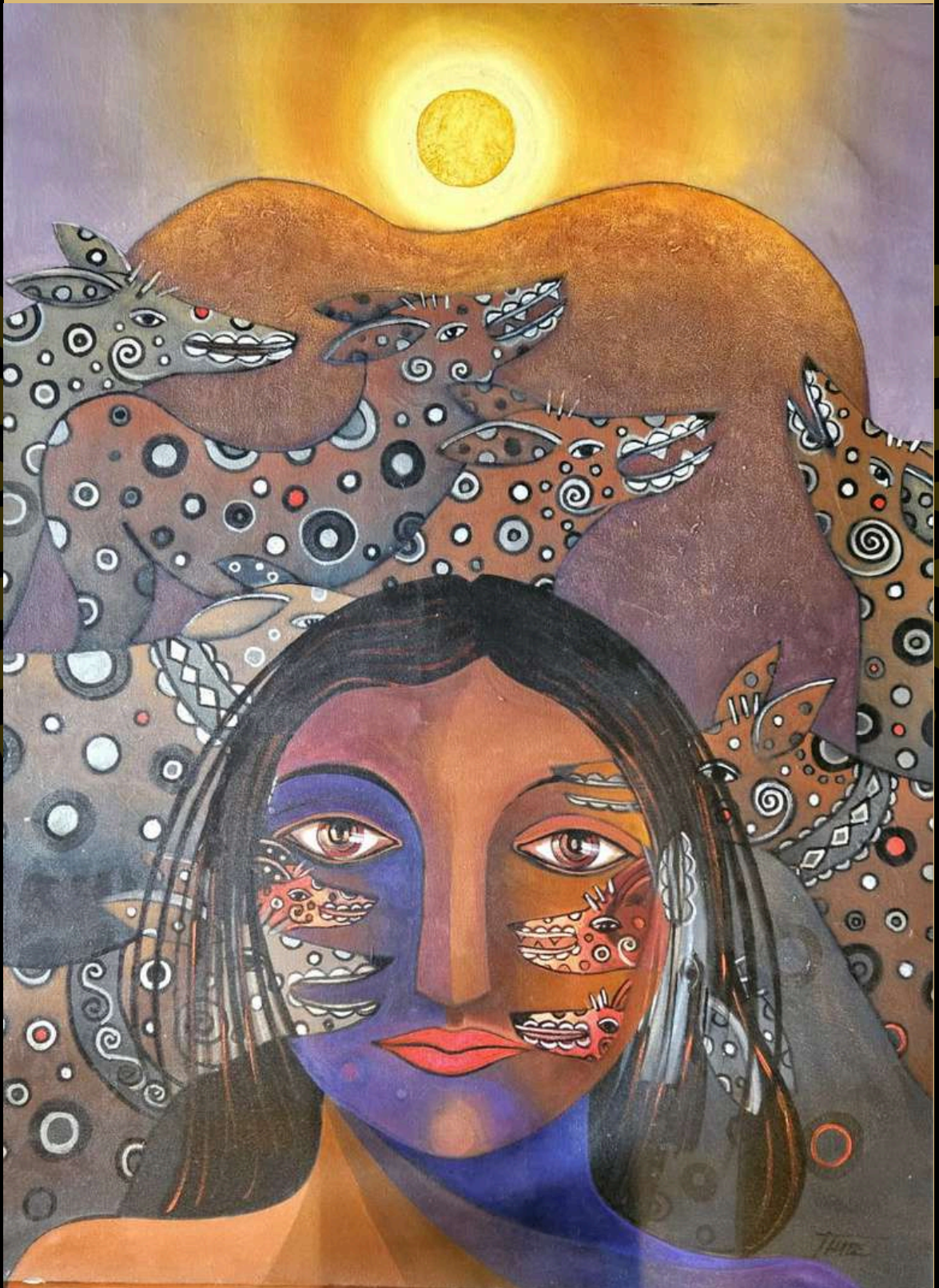

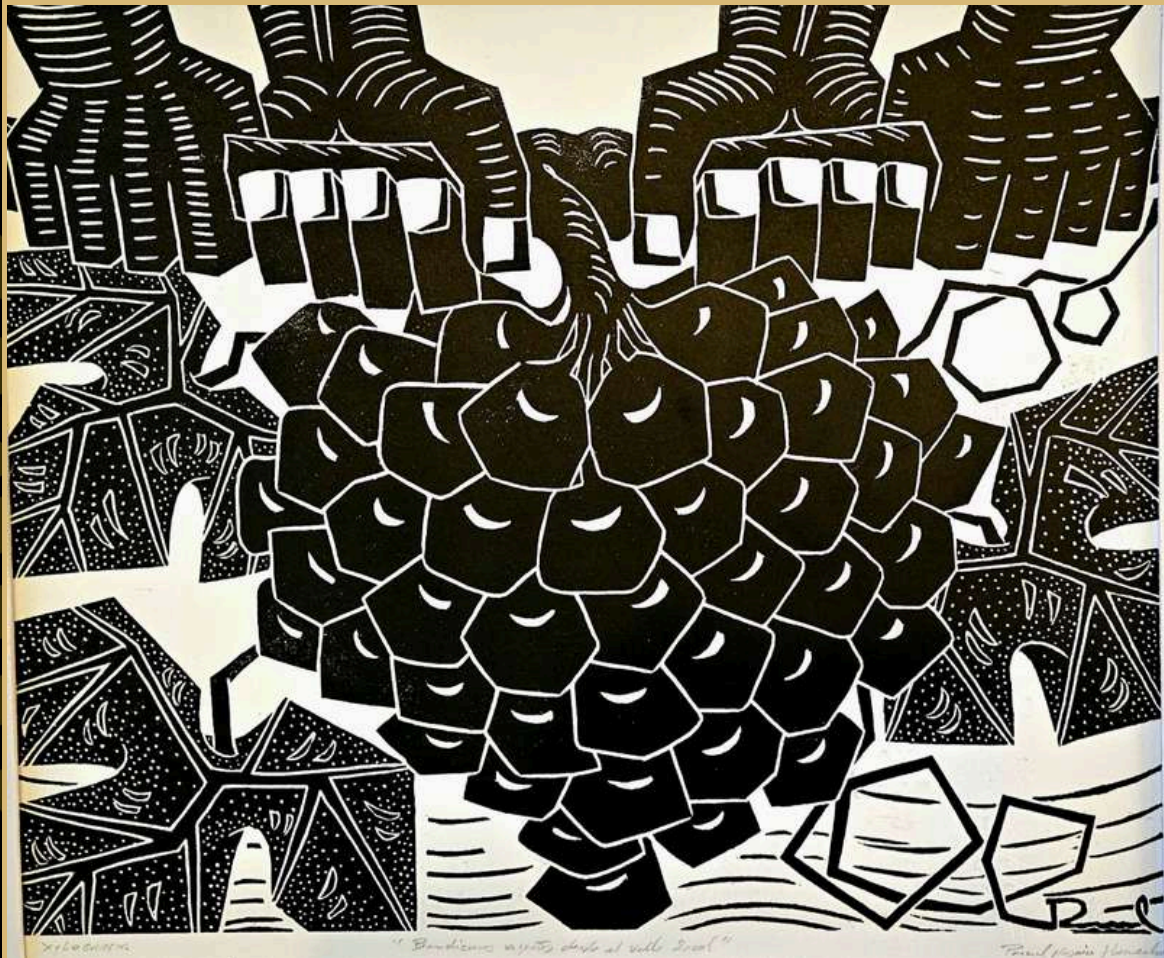

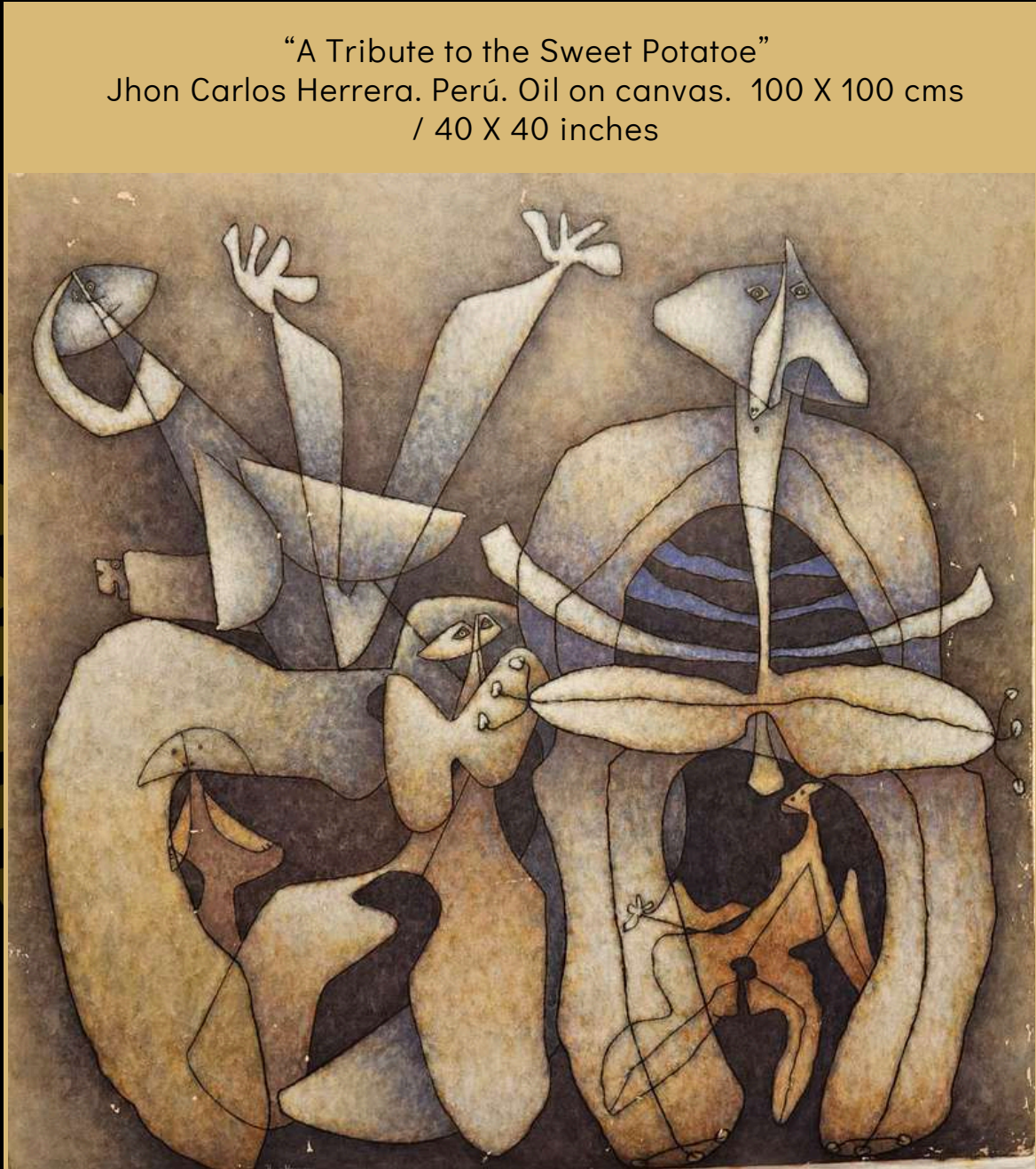


"Bessings from the Valley"
